- Basic formulaic expressions
- Basic vocabulary and phrases related to common objects and people
- Short and simple requests and directions
- Short and simple text about everyday experiences.

### ***The TOEFL Primary® Reading and Listening Test Step 2 (10-11 ages)***

Intended for students who have developed some communicative skills

Tests understanding of:

- Basic expressions, requests, phrases and directions
- Simple and short stories and conversations on topics beyond everyday experiences
- Unfamiliar words presented with contextual clues
- Simple content-based texts


